

Iran: Opening the Way for Israel

At the beginning of July Rafsanjani said in an interview with CNN Iran would not seek to block a peace agreement between Syria and Israel - 'If there is going to be a peace which makes Syria content, we will not have any problem with Syria.'

In a recent statement issued by the Arab League, Adnan Omran, under-secretary general for political affairs said, 'The international impotence by the United Nations, NATO and European Unions...raises a dangerous question which is 'Are we facing a form of racism?' He also said, 'We ask international community to take harsh measures to stop the continues Serbian massacres and crimes to save the reputation and prestige of the United Nations.'

Comment: We do not accept any statement that says that Muslims are being discriminated against by the Western world, nor do we believe that they are dragging their feet when it comes to helping the Muslims.
