

The Northern Alliance Betrays Islam and the Muslims

Introduction

- ◆ **“As for those who take the Kafir as allies in preference to the believers, do they hope to be honoured by them, when behold all honour (Izza) belongs to Allah alone”**
- ◆ **“Alladheena yatta hidhoonal kaafireena awliya min doonil mu'mineen, ayabtaghoona inda humul izzata fa innal izzata lillahi jami'a” [TMQ An-Nisa: 139]**
- ◆ **“O you who believe! Take not the Jews and Christians as your allies...”**
- ◆ In these ayahs and in numerous others throughout the Book of Allah (swt), Allah (swt) forbids the alliance with the Kuffar.
- ◆ Alliance with the Kuffar is a great crime in the sight of Allah (swt).
- ◆ Co-operation with the Kuffar in killing Muslims and occupying the Islamic lands is co-operation upon enmity towards Islam and the Muslims.
- ◆ The recent events in Afghanistan show blatantly the great crime of allying with the Kuffar in order to boycott and kill the Muslims.
- ◆ The Islamic Ummah is well aware that the West could not have fought against the Muslims of Afghanistan if the Muslim rulers did not allow her to land her troops in their countries or grant them facilities for passage via air or sea.
- ◆ Had they stood firmly in front of her they would have not left for her any dominance in any Muslim country and they would not have allowed her to monopolise any part of Muslim wealth.
- ◆ The Muslims are well aware that the alliance of Saudi, Turkey, Pakistan and other nations with the Western nations allowed the West to butcher thousands of Afghan Muslims in the name of “fighting terrorism”.

- ◆ What is more saddening for the Muslims is that the US is the one who incited wars the world over, killed Muslims and conspired to kill Muslims, yet these treacherous Muslim rulers make their Qibla the capitals of the West.

The Northern Alliance Comes to Power

- ◆ What I wanted to discuss today is the recent developments in Afghanistan and the consequences they have for the Muslim Ummah.
- ◆ Everyone will have seen that the Northern Alliance, or the United National and Islamic Front for the Salvation of Afghanistan as they prefer to be called, now has almost overall control over Afghanistan.
- ◆ In a matter of just a few weeks the Northern Alliance who for many years had been trying to uproot the Taliban regime of Afghanistan have been able to seize Kabul, Herat, Jalalabad, Mazari Sharif and most of the other cities of Afghanistan.
- ◆ They were able to achieve such a feat due to their betrayal of Islam and the Muslims – they allied with the West, and helped the West in her campaign against the Muslims of Afghanistan – they worked side by side with Western special forces in order to massacre and kill the Muslims of Afghanistan.
- ◆ The scenes of rejoicing from the Northern Alliance while their fellow Muslims were slaughtered by carpet bombing was the height of betrayal and ignorance.
- ◆ Rabbani was reminded by Hizb ut-Tahrir, **“to return to his Deen and to his Iman and end all cooperation with America; and not only this but also to stand in the ranks of his Ummah against America to stop them from entering his land and to prevent America from the destruction of Afghanistan.”**
- ◆ Unfortunately he did not heed such advice, and did not heed the commands of Allah (swt) and His Messenger (saw).
- ◆ Is this surprising given his long desire to gain a few crumbs from the Western nations – last year at the UN Millennium Summit he said, “We desire the creation of a broad-based government in Afghanistan under the auspices of the United Nations”.
- ◆ The treachery of the Northern Alliance and her betrayal of Islam and the Muslims is inexcusable.

- ◆ The Northern Alliance has opened the door to political, economic and military cooperation with the West even though it is the Western nations that oppressed and attacked the Muslims.
- ◆ They occupied our homes and stole our resources.
- ◆ They are a real foe to Islam and Muslims.
- ◆ How can the foe be made an arbitrator and how is it justified to go to them to solve disputes and problems?
- ◆ To go to them to ask them to remove an oppression is like a sheep going to a rabid wolf to seek refuge and protection.
- ◆ It is saddening that instead of adopting Islam as their reference point, from which systems, laws and policies are derived, the Afghan factions meeting in Bonn have adopted International Law - a Kufr law - as their reference point.
- ◆ Hence, they plan to refer to it and comply with its systems and laws, in execution of the commands of the Kufr states – under the umbrella of erecting a ‘broad-based government’ in Afghanistan.
- ◆ The West have great reason to rejoice – they are en route to achieving their aims for Afghanistan – and they have left the dirty work to the Muslims.
- ◆ They have used the airspace and bases of the Muslim countries to slaughter the Muslims.
- ◆ They have used the ground troops of the Northern Alliance to end the power of the Taliban in Afghanistan.
- ◆ Such betrayal and treachery was unknown in the glorious history of Islam under the time of the Islamic Khilafah.
- ◆ When the Romans offered to help Muawiya in his dispute with Imam Ali, Muawiya replied to the Romans by telling them that once he had resolved his dispute he would come and destroy their authority on the earth – he did not allow the Kuffar to take advantage of disagreements between Muslims.
- ◆ Similarly; the lofty and high stance taken by Ka’b bin Malik al-Ansari when a letter reached him from King Ghassan in which he said: “The news has reached us that your companion is treating you harshly but Allah has not made you to live in a land of disgrace and loss. So join us and we will treat you well...”

- ◆ All that Ka'b could do was to tear up the letter and burn it and not separate from his Deen and Ummah.
- ◆ This ought to have the stance of the Muslim rulers and the Northern Alliance to the requests for co-operation from the Western Kafir States.

So what now?

- ◆ So what can the Muslim Ummah now expect from the latest change in the political landscape in Afghanistan?
- ◆ I would like you to consider two questions
- ◆ Firstly: Can we expect the new regime in Afghanistan to implement Islam?
- ◆ As for whether they can be expected to implement Islam, the answer to this remains clear for all to see.
- ◆ Firstly, they have shown no intention of establishing the Shari'ah of Allah (swt) on the earth – indeed they have violated most of the commands of Allah (swt) by their co-operation with the Kuffar, and their torturing and killing of the Muslims of Afghanistan.
- ◆ Indeed the factions involved have all stated their desire to have a “broad-based” government for Afghanistan, and respect for the rule of democracy.
- ◆ Secondly, could it even be conceivable that a regime brought to power by Western airpower and military might would be allowed to implement Islam?
- ◆ This would be impossible, given the West's hatred of Islam and her continuing crusade against Islam and the Muslims, and given that one of her objectives in this campaign is to establish a presence in the region whereby she can prevent the emergence of the Islamic Khilafah from either Central or South Asia.
- ◆ The second question to be considered is whether or not the new regime in Afghanistan will be independent of the Western states.
- ◆ Is it conceivable that the Northern Alliance and the other Afghan factions like that of the ex-King Zahir Shah, could be independent of the West given the fact that they allied with the West and were the most outspoken proponents of the Crusade against Islam and the Muslims?

- ◆ Jack Straw, the British Foreign Secretary said about the Northern Alliance **“Well, they are not objecting to the positioning of British troops in Afghanistan. The Northern Alliance have actually welcomed the use of coalition military force to help eliminate the Taliban and the Al-Qu'eda organisation and have been working closely in that respect.”**
- ◆ The butcher of the Chechen people, President Vladimir Putin said that Russia would **“expand cooperation with the internationally recognised Afghan government of Rabbani and give its armed forces additional assistance in the form of weapons supplies.”** (25/9/01).
- ◆ In fact the Afghan factions meeting in Bonn, under the auspices of the UN which is a tool of the West, have already agreed to the deployment of a multinational force to Afghanistan.
- ◆ So it is clear that the post-Taliban Afghanistan will be one that is not militarily independent but one that is policed on a day to day basis by a multinational force, no doubt comprising of UN soldiers.
- ◆ Indeed Rabbani said, **“From now on, what we ask from America and the international community is that instead of sending in their military, the world should send in their peace forces -- their forces for reconstruction to rebuild this ruined country.”**
- ◆ The influential American think tank, the Brookings Institute, said **“A major U.S. and allied peacekeeping operation in Afghanistan would be needed...The need is greatest now, when competition for political advantage is most intense”**
- ◆ So it is clear that the US policy makers and the likes of Rabbani are in agreement about the need for peace-keeping forces in Afghanistan.
- ◆ In addition, the desire for a “broad-based” government under the auspices of the UN suggests that the new set-up in Afghanistan will not be politically independent of the Western nations – but will rather be a regime that is set up with the blessing of the UN and a regime that will remain part of the UN, the very organisation responsible for the embargo on Iraq, the situation in Palestine, Kashmir and the Balkans.
- ◆ Also only recently, the World Bank – that not so charitable of institutions - recently unveiled its own blueprint for the reconstruction of Afghanistan with a list of short, medium and long-term goals.

- ◆ The West has pledged \$10 billion in aid to Afghanistan.
- ◆ This comes as no surprise either since General Lusha Clay, adviser to President Kennedy noted that the aim of giving aid and the criteria which they are given is **“the national security of USA and the security and safety of the Free World.”**
- ◆ So the Muslims can expect that Afghanistan will not have any economic independence from the West – it is already being lined up for help from the World Bank and IMF – the same type of help that has crippled the economies of every single Muslim state in the world.
- ◆ Not only that but the American and European firms are already getting ready to win the lucrative contracts to rebuild war torn Afghanistan – not to mention the contracts for the building of oil and gas pipelines through it – no doubt like the foreign economic influence in other Muslim countries the economic benefits of such schemes will be seen by the shareholders of these massive conglomerates and not the Muslim masses.
- ◆ So in consideration it would appear that Afghanistan will be used by the West to achieve her own interests in the region.
- ◆ In particular, the US hopes that a loyal and stable Afghanistan will bring her three things – (1) the ability to keep a check on China who is a growing regional power (2) the ability to harness the economic potential of the Caspian region and (3) the ability to prevent the re-emergence of the Islamic Khilafah in the region.
- ◆ It is the case that Afghanistan will be yet another puppet, client state of the West, with puppet rulers who serve the West and not their people or ideology.
- ◆ It will be one more added puppet state in the political landscape of the Muslim world which has become characterised by weak, failing states that neither implement Islam nor act independently of the Western nations.

Conclusion

- ◆ My dear Muslim brothers – these are the dangerous consequences of alliance with the Western nations in their campaign against Islam and the Muslims.
- ◆ The rulers of the Islamic countries do not act independently for the sake of their countries, their Ummah and their Deen, nor do they independently design the policies of their countries.

- ◆ They rather act in their policies and in their decisions in accordance to the international powers whom they follow, serving their interests, and consolidating their influence.
- ◆ After this clarification, the scale of the crime which the Northern Alliance perpetrated against Islam and the Muslims becomes apparent.
- ◆ It is also a crime perpetrated against the sincere people from amongst the Da'wah carriers, who work towards establishing the Khilafah and restore the rule by what Allah (swt) has revealed.
- ◆ The Northern Alliance has been struck by the temptation of prestige and power.
- ◆ Their betrayal will be the cause of their loss in this life and in the Akhirah.
- ◆ As for the loss of Rabbani and the Northern Alliance in this life, it will occur when they execute all what the secular West demand of them, and then the West will throw them in the middle of the road, without any regret or sympathy for them, once they have achieved their interests.
- ◆ As for their loss in the hereafter, this will occur when they meet their Creator (swt) who will surely bring them account for what they used to do.
- ◆ **“Wa may yabtaghi ghayral Islaami deenan fa lay yuqbala minhu wa huwa fil aakhirati minal haasireen”**
- ◆ **“And whoever seeks a Deen other than Islam, it will never be accepted from him, and in the Akhirah he will be one of the losers”** [TMQ Ale-Imran: 85]
