

## Circle: The reality of the rule of Kufr

- ◆ The reality of the rule of Kufr is apparent on all levels, locally, nationally and internationally. The Capitalist ideology has resulted in rulers ruling for their own benefit rather than in order to look after the affairs of the people.
- ◆ The national rail crisis which was sparked by the recent rail crash have shown us how the Capitalist government acts not in order to look after the affairs of its people but in reaction to public opinion and outrage. The Labour government doesn't want to gain unpopularity from potential future voters so they have to patch up a problem that was caused due to their own negligence.
- ◆ Internationally – Arafat's meeting on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> November is part of America's greedy plan to gain a foothold in Palestine. Arafat is begging for a UN peace force, i.e. the direct presence of America.
- ◆ The ruler of Egypt considers Jihaad to be madness and the ruler of Iraq is calling for Jihaad but the blood of the Muslims on his hand, since he came to power, has not dried yet. The ruler of Jordan, which shares the longest geographical borders with Palestine, considers cutting relations with the Jews and abolishing the peace process as defeat. As for the ruler of Yemen he was the first one to rush towards calling for war but as soon as the American destroyer in the Port of Aden was bombed he appeared like a frightened slave who did not know how to regain the affections of his master. The petro-rulers in Kuwait, the Gulf and in other places consider cutting the oil supply to Kuffaar as incitement of the industrial world against the Muslims and damaging to the world economy. The rulers of Saudi Arabia have stated this more than once.

Al-Harth narrated on the authority of Ibn Masood that the messenger (saw) said: **"For every matter, there is a thing that spoils it, and what spoils this deen is the evil rulers"**. [Imam Suyooti : Saheeh]

"On the authority of Abu Musa(ra), the messenger of Allah (saw) said: **"In the hellfire there is a valley, and in this valley there is a well called "Hababah", it is duty upon Allah to reside in this well every stubborn oppressor (ruler)"**. [Narrared by Tabarani and its Isnad is Hasan]

**"Any leader of a ten men or more, he will be brought in the judgment day chained until either the justice will unchain him or the oppression will chain him"**. [Narrared by Al-Bazzar, and the men in the chain are Saheeh]

- ◆ The concept of ruling in Islam is completely different. Politics in Islam is to look after the affairs of people. Compare the present rulers to some examples of rulers in the past. E.g. The Prophet (saw) once went to the minbar, sat down, praised Allah (swt), and prayed for peace upon the companions of Uhud, and forgiveness for them and prayed much for them, then said:

*"...and furthermore, oh people, I praise Allah between you, of whom there is no Lord worthy of worship other than Him. It has been made known to me that there are some (unfulfilled) rights between yourselves, so whoever I have whipped his back (unjustly), this is my back, so take back your right, and if I have vilified someone's honour, this is my honour, so take back your right. Although resentment is not in my nature, nor my disposition, but you would be beloved to me if you took from me what was rightfully yours, or if you forgave me that right, so I can meet Allah (swt) with my soul at ease, and even this, I do not see as sufficient until I undertake (the responsibility) over and over again."*

- ◆ Even though America and the side of Kufr, together with all its helpers, the United nations, the world media, the IMF, the world bank, NATO and all their forces stand against the Ummah and attempt to destroy Islam the Ummah of Islam remains steadfast upon Islam and the side of those working to re-establish the Khilafah.
- ◆ The fact that young children are fighting on the streets of Palestine calling for Jihad, the fact that Muslims from all parts of the globe whether in Egypt, Yemen, Uzbekistan or Indonesia are calling for Jihad and the liberation of Palestine and some even being fought by their own regimes like in Jordan – The fact that this is occurring shows that the Ummah of Islam will not give up Islam, the fact that this is occurring shows us that the Kuffar will never be able to win the war against Islam.
- ◆ **We have to be part of this work and momentum to bring back Islam and not on the side of the Kuffar who are working against it.**

On the authority of Sahl Ibn Saad Al-Sa'idi (ra), the messenger (saw) said **"Islam began strange, and it shall return strange as it began, so "Tooba" to the strangers. They said: O messenger of Allah "who are the strangers?". He (saw) said: "They are the ones who upright the society when the people become corrupt". Salla Allahu alaihi wasallam. "Tooba" in the donya is the great khair from Allah by giving those ones the yaqeen and by giving them guidance, and in the akhira "tooba" is a tree in the paradise in which it takes the rider to cut its shadow one hundred years.** [The hadith is narrated by Tabarani, and the men in the chain are Saheeh except for Bakr Ibn Saleem, he is trustworthy.]

### ***US ready to consider peace force for ME***

WASHINGTON, Nov 7: The United States signalled on Monday it would be willing to consider Palestinian appeals for an international force to patrol the West Bank and Gaza, backing off from an earlier categorical rejection of the idea.

The change, communicated subtly in public comments at the White House and State Department and enunciated more clearly in private, comes as Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat and Israeli Prime Minister Ehud Barak prepare to visit Washington for separate talks with US President Bill Clinton.

"There is a slight shift from Friday," a senior State Department official said, referring to the sharp US opposition to such a force registered last week during a visit here by senior Palestinian negotiator Saeb Erekat.

Erekat had been pushing the idea ahead of Arafat's trip to Washington this Thursday.

"We'll hear them out," the official said of the Palestinian request.

He stressed, however, that the United States would not support anything that Israel - which is now vehemently opposed to the entire concept - and Washington did not believe the United Nations should be involved in.

"I can't speculate about what might be acceptable, but we're not looking for a UN resolution or anything within the UN system," the official said. "We're prepared to look at something different."

The Palestinians have been pushing hard for a UN force of 2,000 military observers, and the Security Council is expected to take up a draft proposal for one on Wednesday.

On Sunday, Arafat renewed the call, telling CBS television's "60 Minutes" program that the force was needed "to protect us, to stop attacks against our people" by Israeli troops.

Citing an Israeli source, the Jerusalem Post reported Monday that Washington was floating a proposal for an unarmed force that would have observer status similar to that of a group organized after a mosque massacre in Hebron in 1994.

That force, the Temporary International Presence in Hebron, is composed of 30 Norewegians.

At the White House, spokesman Jake Siewert studiously refused to address the issue, though he would not confirm or deny its substance.

"I'm not going to discuss what we may or may not be exploring with the parties," Siewert told reporters. "I'm not going to discuss negotiating stances here at this podium."-

### **UN peace force needs Israel's support - Annan**

Paris - The United Nations needs the agreement and co-operation of Israel before deploying international peacekeepers to the West Bank and Gaza, secretary-general Kofi Annan said on Tuesday.

Palestine's leader, Yasser Arafat, is expected to push for UN peacekeepers when he meets America's President Bill Clinton this week - but the Israelis have already expressed their opposition to the idea.

"For the United Nations to deploy such a force you need the agreement and co-operation of both sides," said Annan in an interview on Europe One radio.

"We have already had the reply of the Israel's prime minister, (Ehud) Barak, who said he could not accept this. I do not know how we could do this without the agreement and co-operation of the Israeli government," he added.

### **'Despite the difficulties we have to push for peace'**

Annan renewed his appeal for an end to the violence that has racked Israel and the Palestinian territories for nearly six weeks, leaving at least 176 people dead.

"If we can calm the situation, we can encourage the two leaders to talk and sit down at the same table," said Annan.

"I'm very worried because if we can't calm the situation ... it is not just the region that will suffer, but the whole world."

Despite the troubles, Annan said he thought the Middle East peace process was still alive. "It is not dead. I have hope because there is no alternative. Despite the difficulties we have to push for peace."

He urged Arafat not to push ahead with his long-standing threat to declare independence for a Palestinian state.

"I hope that he doesn't do that ... it would be better to continue the peace process than to make unilateral declarations," Annan said, adding: "I don't think it would help. It would complicate things." - Reuters
